About the Hospital:

Quincy Valley Medical Center is a highly unique and progressive rural hospital. Quincy Medical is a designated Critical Access Hospital. The Hospital serves a growing population and is centrally located directly between Seattle and Spokane. The organization is also planning replacement of the Hospital facilities and is evolving to meet the growing needs of the community. The Hospital is directed by expert executive leadership and a highly competent and dynamic board of directors. This leadership has helped the Hospital realize recent financial growth with volume increases the past three years. The Hospital currently employs approximately 145 people.

About the Position:

The Hospital is currently recruiting for a committed physician to join its vibrant Clinic. The ideal physician practices and promotes a continuum of care from preventive to acute care management. Our client seeks a collaborative leader who understands healing systems. This is a lifestyle group with moderate hospital admissions call, (1:4). In addition to traditional internal medicine services, Quincy Valley Medical offers specialized programs including physical therapy, massage therapy, nutrition counseling, podiatry, cosmetic care, along with mental health care and osteoporosis testing programs.

The clinic is comprised of two Nurse Practitioners in addition to a professional and stable support team. The clinic currently has a volume of 500-600 patients per month. The NP's typically focus on women's health and pediatric patient needs. The clinic offers same day appointments, a busy practice while still allowing quality time per patient and an opportunity to serve a diverse patient population.

Preferred Experience:

- Ideal candidates will be certified in internal medicine, family practice or osteopathic medicine
- Knowledge base experience of complimentary healthcare
- 5 years of practice experience is preferred
- Candidates must have a commitment to working in an interdisciplinary team of physicians and allied health professionals.

Requirements:

- Board Certified in the state of Washington
- Doctorate Degree in Medicine from an accredited college approved by the liaison committee on Medical Education and Hospitals of the American Medical Association, a Doctorate Degree in Osteopathy from a college accredited by the American Osteopathic Association *and or* permanent Certification by the Educational Commission for foreign Medical Graduates (ECFMG) is acceptable
- Board Certification in Family Practice from the American Board of Family Practice, the American Association of Physician Specialists, or the American Osteopathic Association
- Possess and maintain a current, unrestricted license to practice medicine in the state of Washington
- Possess pertinent clinical experience within the preceding 2 years as a Family Practice Physician
- Current certification in ACLS, BLS, and PALS preferred

Salary and Benefits:

This position is a permanent employment position with an annual salary and benefits package (including malpractice coverage). A monthly bonus plan is available after the first year. A standardized relocation package is included. Please note that Washington does not require personal income taxes for its residents.

Community Overview:

Quincy is located near the center of Washington State just 10 miles North of I-90. The City of Quincy has a population of 5,700 with a rural community total population of approximately 13,000. City facilities include a Library, Aquatic Center, six parks with picnic sites and a museum.

Quincy is the gateway to the Wenatchee Valley, Leavenworth and the Okanogan Valley. The area is one of the sunniest places in Washington and a common weekend getaway for those living in the Puget Sound area.

Downtown Seattle is a gorgeous and relaxing drive just 150 miles from Quincy. Spokane is just a two hour drive. Both cities offer major airports, a plethora of upscale shopping, fine dining and abundant outdoor recreational activities. Mt. Spokane offers top rated black diamond runs and is one of 15 ski resorts in the state. Moses Lake is a 45 minute drive and offers fantastic golf, boating, hunting and luxurious hotel accommodations.

Tourism is a major part of the economy. The Gorge Amphitheater, which draws an estimated 3,000 to 20,000 people per concert, is located 10 miles southwest of Quincy. Sunland Estates summer homes and the Crescent Bar Recreation area all add to the tourism along with the already available hunting, fishing, and boating. Quincy is considered a tourist and recreational paradise.
