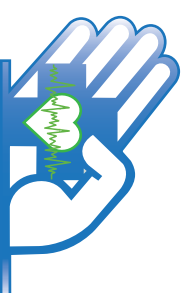

C1. Basic Life Support for the Community (CPR)

10:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.

This course is recommended for individuals who are interested in the basics of CPR. This class meets requirements for jobs needing a CPR card in a non-health care environment. *CPR card issued with completion of practical and written test.*

\$45 for both Basic Life Support and Community First Aid if taken together.

C2. Community First Aid
