## *Event benefits Quincy hospital foundation*

QUINCY — The Quincy Valley Hospital Foundation brings together music, wine and fine dining in an outdoor atmosphere Saturday.

Tickets to Red, Wine and Blues are \$55 at the door. The price includes a steak and salmon dinner provided by Michael's On The Lake, wine, and rock-blues entertainment from Seattle's Becki, Sue and Her Big Rockin' Daddies.

The event is at Parties on the Green at

Twin Firs Turf, located at 7737 Road L.5 N.W. in Quincy. Doors open at 6 p.m., with the buffet line forming at 6:30 p.m. and music at 7:30 p.m. Attendees must be at least 21 years old.

Proceeds from tickets sales go to the Quincy Valley Hospital Foundation.

Marketing and Public Relations Director Michele Wurl said the event is in its second year, and last year was a success.

"I think there was about 125 people," Wurl said.

The event brought in \$2,500 for the foundation.

She said so far, 160 tickets have been sold to this year's event.

Half of the ticket pays for food and the

remaining benefits the foundation, Wurl said. She said her goal was to get donations and sponsorships for the event so all of the proceeds, after the cost of catering, could go to the foundation.

Non-alcoholic beverages are included in the price, as well as a bottle of wine at each table. Five types of wine and four types of beer are offered as well. Wine is \$5 per glass or \$20 for a bottle, and beer is \$3.50 each.

Art by Ana Candioti and Kerry Siderius is available for sale at the event, with a portion of sales going to the foundation, Wurl said.
