For the last 20 plus years my family have been strong supporters of the Quincy Valley Medical Center community. From broken arms, car wrecks, school physicals and other personal, even life-threatening emergencies. We have voted for all the bond requests, sent our children there and at no time have had any complaints about the medical service.

Now our use has diminished as our children have grown up and I as a disabled Veteran use the veteran's system. There were times in the past the billing systems caused such confusion we took our medical service or specialty needs elsewhere.

In June of this year, at the request of the Veterans Hospital in Spokane, I was to get a personal procedure done at any hospital or clinic. This was done to reduce the cost and time to the VA system.

The quoted cost at Wenatchee was, (\$1,200 to \$1,400) and Moses Lake, (\$1,200 to \$1,800) for similar procedure cost. The net cost to the VA at Quincy was \$1,285.

In anticipation that with the new management and doctors committed to staying, I chose Quincy. As in the past, the medical service was excellent. All in all, a very good deal.
