SageView Family Care: QVMC celebrates the grand opening of the new Family Care clinic

Quincy Valley Medical Center (QVMC) celebrated the grand opening of the Medical Center's newly renovated clinic on January 24th with a bit of mystery and speculation.

After a month of rumors and mysterious looking ad's featuring tattooed faces, QVMC completed and opened the ambitious and long awaited clinic renovation project. The new clinic, named **SageView Family Care** opened on January 24th to fan fair, food, tattooed faces and a huge turn out from the community.

With the renovation now complete, **SageView Family Care** provides offices for 4 or more doctors with 13 completely renovated examination rooms. The entire project completely during a closure of the clinic over the holidays improved every area of the clinic. With new paint, carpet, major repairs, flooring, furniture and more the renovation also included the creation of the clinics future "**Specialty Services Wing**" with more space and room for future community specialty services (in development).

QVMC will continue to renovate other areas within the Medical Center as changes in both medical services, treatments and technologies require upgrading the environment of patient care. Renovation in the Radiology Department and the Medical Centers Main Entrance are next on the list and will take place in phases over the next few months. "Phased planning for the renovations are being done in such a way in order to keep patient impact at a minimum" said Dick Burkenpas, Director of Marketing.

How did QVMC accomplish SageView? With \$20,000, strong backing from the Board of Commissioners and the support of many volunteers, community members as well as a few local business's, the Medical Center made this community improvement project a reality for the people of Quincy and the surrounding area.

The clinic renovations will encourage a positive outlook in patients from the moment they walk through the front door. Medical Center, CEO Mehdi Merred, stated "everything we do is geared toward the benefit of the patient and to our community." "We are also excited with the future of providing Specialty Services to the community and to the growth of the **SageView** practice with Dr Klingner and Dr Cornu-Labat."
